

PNAM B2 English Exam Description

Reading: 35 minutes (25%)

(2 reading texts)

Possible task types:

- a text followed by multiple-choice questions,
- a text from which sentences have been removed and placed in a jumbled order, together with an additional sentence.
- a text or several short texts with multiple-matching questions.

Writing: 40 minutes (25%)

(1 writing – 140-190 words)

2 options – choose 1

Possible task types: email (formal or informal), essay, review, report or article.

Listening: approximately 30 minutes (25%)

(3 listening tasks)

You will hear each listening extract TWICE.

Possible task types:

- gap fill
- multiple matching
- multiple choice

Speaking: Approx. 12/18 minutes (25%)

You will take the Speaking test in pairs (or a group of 3) and you will be tested on your ability to take part in different types of interaction: with the examiner, with the other candidates, and by yourself.

Part 1 – The examiner will ask you some questions (individual).

Part 2 – You have to compare 2 pictures, answer a question about the pictures and briefly answer a question about your partner's topic (individual).

Part 3 – You have to discuss a situation with your partner(s) using pictures or written prompts given to you by the examiner (group), and you will be asked questions related to the topics in part 3.
