Accomodation in Ravensburg:

Accommodation costs will be covered by the participant. We have pre-reserved a selection of rooms in one hotel (Residenz). The pre-reserved rooms will be held for us until **15 March 2025**; please book directly with the hotel, using the booking code "DHBW Partnership Week 2025" kontakt@residenz-ravensburg.de

Hotel Residenz: 95 Euro for a single room, 105 Euro for a double room, single occupancy, 135 Euro for double occupancy. Breakfast is included in the price (if only one night is booked, the price is slightly higher). www.residenz-ravensburg.de

For participants on a tight budget, the **Gasthof Ochsen** is another option. It is a simple guest-house with fewer facilities than a normal hotel. Another good option is **Hotel Ochsen** am Mehlsack, a hotel with the same owner as the Gasthof Ochsen, it can, therefore, also be booked under the same link, www.ochsen-rv.de

The hotels above are all within a few minutes walking distance from our campus buildings in the town center. You can also find other attractive offers under www.booking.com

Travel to Ravensburg:

The closest airport to Ravensburg is Friedrichshafen; from there it is 20 minutes to Ravensburg with a commuter train running every hour. Other suitable airports with good railroad connections to Ravensburg are located in Stuttgart, Zurich, Munich and Memmingen (served by budget airlines such as Ryanair). Even the biggest airport in Germany, Frankfurt, is only 3½ hours away with train. https://www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml

A cheap way to travel within Germany is to go by bus, normally the tickets need to be pre-reserved and paid online in order to secure a seat. One company is Flixbus, www.flixbus.de.
